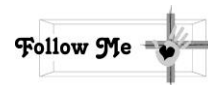

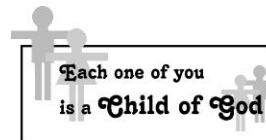

A FRESH PERSPECTIVE ON THE SUNDAY READINGS

HIS WORD TODAY by Rev. William J. Reilly

"For all of you were baptized into Christ. There is neither Jew nor Greek, there is neither slave nor free person, there is no male or female, for you are all one in Christ Jesus. And if you belong to Christ, then you are Abraham's descendant, heirs according to the promise, 'Who do the crowds say that I am?'"

The church is a catholic or universal church. The membership is widespread. We are multicultural, with varying languages, customs, traditions and experiences, yet we are one. St. Paul addressed this reality in his letter. If he could speak to a single community in this way during the early days of the church, how much more so today. What a blessing is found in our diversity as we learn from one another. How special it is to find others journeying with Christ toward our final destination. An archbishop looked up at a mosaic in a church and after admiring its beauty, called our attention to the richness produced by the blending of each and every stone. Were a stone missing, the beauty would be marred. If one fell out of place, the entire image would be diminished. I am asked like Christ asked: 'who am I in the church?' I too am like a beautiful gem, placed here by God, to make His kingdom more beautiful by what I say and do. I, linked with others, am part of the body of Christ, to bring His presence to others. May we see the beauty of the church of Christ in each individual and reflect that beauty by our words and action.
