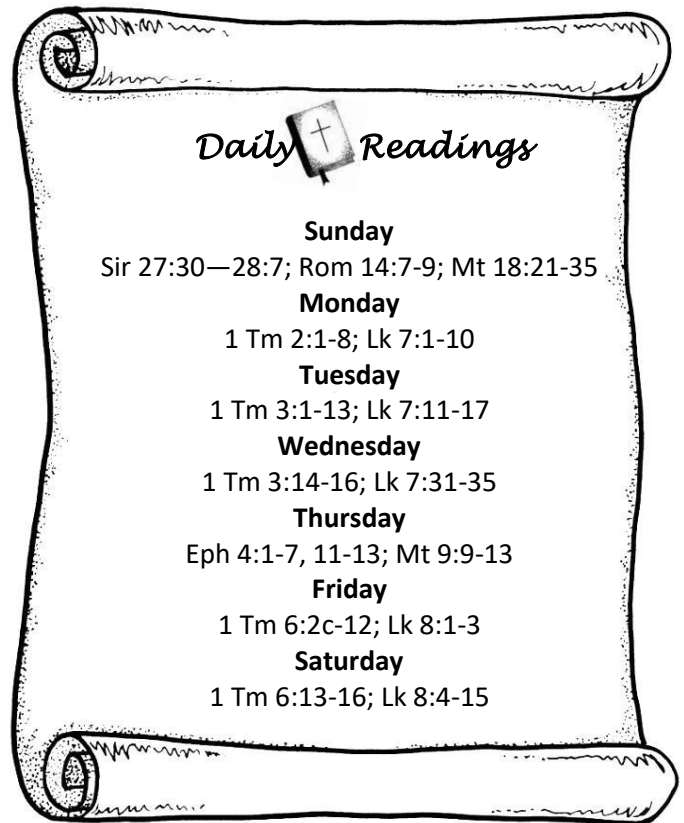

**A FRESH PERSPECTIVE ON THE SUNDAY READINGS**

**HIS WORD TODAY** by Rev. William J. Reilly



"Forgive your neighbor's injustices, then when you pray, your own sins will be forgiven. Could anyone nourish anger against another and expect healing from the Lord? Could anyone refuse mercy to another like himself can he seek pardon for his own sins?... Remember your last days, set enmity aside, remember death and decay, and cease from sin. Think of the commandments hate not your neighbor, remember the Most High's covenant and overlook faults."

When we consider the word power, we might think of electricity, strength, or brute force. The greatest power available is not material, physical or even emotional. The greatest power resides in every person, yet often goes unused.

The scriptures today reflect that power and it is found in the word forgiveness. Every person has the power to forgive. In our world beset with hatred, war, and discrimination rarely do we resort to the use of this power. We are set on dominating, getting even, putting others in their place. We judge, presume intentions and motivation, yet fail to see the splinter in our own eye. The power to forgive is a gift for use, for my own well-being and for others. I recall a wise old priest who directed others to 'look the other way'.

**UNA FRESCA PERSPECTIVA DE LAS LECTURAS DOMINICALES  
SU PALABRA HOY** por el Reverendo William J. Reilly



“Perdona el agravio a tu prójimo y entonces, cuando ores, serán absueltos tus pecados. Si un hombre mantiene su enojo contra otro, ¿cómo pretende que el Señor lo sane? No tiene piedad de un hombre semejante a él ¡y se atreve a implorar por sus pecados!... Acuérdate del fin, y deja de odiar; piensa en la corrupción y en la muerte; acuérdate de los mandamientos, y no guardes rencor a tu prójimo; piensa en la Alianza del Altísimo, y pasa por alto la ofensa.”

Cuando consideramos la palabra poder, quizá pensemos en electricidad, vigor, o fuerza bruta. El mayor poder disponible no es material, físico ni emocional. El mayor poder reside en cada persona, aunque a menudo no se utiliza. Las escrituras hoy reflejan ese poder y se encuentra en el perdón. Cada persona tiene el poder de perdonar. En este mundo lleno de odio, guerra y discriminación, raramente recurrimos al uso de este poder. Estamos determinados a dominar, a vengarnos, a poner a otros en su lugar. Juzgamos, asumimos intenciones y motivación, y sin embargo fallamos en ver la viga en nuestro propio ojo. El poder del perdón es un don para ser utilizado para mi propio bien y el de otros. Recuerdo a un anciano y sabio sacerdote que aconsejaba ‘hacernos los distraídos’.

Join us for Eucharistic Adoration, the Chaplet of Divine Mercy & the Holy Rosary every first Sunday of the month at 3:00 PM.



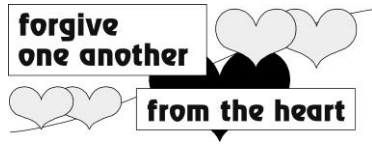
**Sacred Heart Parish Rosary Society**
